Each team will play a minimum of 3 matches, and other benefits include a large screen television onsite to watch the quarter finals of the FIFA World Cup, the use of all amenities such as a bar, restaurant, toilets, showers, etc. If you are camping on-site, please complete the last question on the form below, and add this camping fee to your team(s) registration(s) fees. Details of your matches and times will be sent to you 10 days prior to the tournament commencing. Initially, all teams will play in a league system, with the best teams qualifying for the latter stages of the competition, which will be the knock-out phase.

Terms & Conditions

1. Swamp Soccer is a fun event and teams must participate in a sportsmanlike manner.
2. Unfortunately there will be no refunds for teams who cancel or fail to turn up.
3. A team representative must report to the Information Tent 30 minutes before your first match, to inform the organisers that your team is present.
4. Each team must wear an outfit that clearly identifies the team. e.g. same colour of tops. Fancy dress is allowed.
5. Participating teams must adhere to the rules of Swamp Soccer. The rules are available to view at www.swampsoccer.co.uk
6. Footwear can be training shoes or football boots. Metal studs are not allowed.
7. For teams camping onsite, please be considerate to other campers. Inappropriate behaviour, such as rowdiness, damage to property, fires and theft may lead to legal action, and the offenders will be removed from the site.
8. Swamp Soccer UK Ltd cannot be held responsible for any damage or theft to teams' tents & valuables. Please store any valuables in a safe place (e.g. car).
9. Food and refreshments will be available at the Swamp Soccer Arena. We strongly discourage any teams to bring their own supplies of alcohol.
10. There will be a public transport service from Dunoon (the nearest town) to the Swamp Soccer Arena. A timetable will be made available on the Swamp Soccer website a few weeks before the event.
11. Swamp Soccer attracts a high level of media coverage. By entering a team you are agreeing to pictures and images of your team appearing in various media outlets. For any television interviews, media personnel will initially seek your permission to cooperate, before any filming commences.
12. Teams should consider insurance coverage. Though serious injuries are highly unlikely, Swamp Soccer UK will not be held responsible for any players who pick up injuries whilst attending and/or playing in this tournament.
